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Short history of the probation system in Slovenia

- 1978 – Centers for social welfare – special role within social reintegration of offenders – good practice
- ✓ Penal Enforcement Act – duties for CSW in penal field



Legislator divided powers of CSM to 2 Ministries (Ministry of Justice, Ministry of Labour, Family, Social Affairs)

Main competences

SETTLEMENT PROCEDURE

- community service
- general work in benefit of victim

SUSPENDED PROSECUTION

- community service
- submission to a course of medical treatment
 - sessions of vocal, psychological or other consultations

RELEASE ON PAROLE UNDER CUSTODIAL SUPERVISION

SUSPENDED SENTENCE WITH CUSTODIAL SUPERVISION

- submission to a course of medical treatment
- sessions of vocal, psychological or other consultations
 - different restraining orders
- qualification for a job, to take employment suitable to offenders health, skills

SERVING OF PRISON SENTENCE

- community service
- house imprisonment
 - weekend prison

Statistics of 2015 – based on the main competences

- 01. 09. 2015 = 1399 prisoners; 67/100.000
01. 09. 2016= 1308 prisoners; 63/100.000
- Suspended sentence with custodial supervision: 181
- Serving of prison sentence: 86 community service, 24 house imprisonment, 114 weekend prison
- Release on parole with custodial supervision: 32

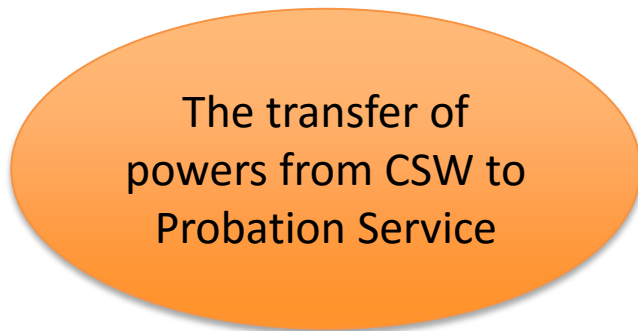
