Anchoring	national (and local)	global (virtual)
Temporality	continue (public service requisite)	discontinue (flexibility of enterprise and workers)
Obligations	means (negotiable)	results (evaluable)
Client	convict and society	State
Culture	resistance => flexibility of social (clinical) intervention	satisfaction => rigidity of a codified (technical) intervention
Client satisfaction	quantitatively non-measurable	quantitatively measurable
Projection	reductionist	inflationist
