Directors General convene in Oslo to determine priorities





The project's full name is 'Developing the Use of Technical Tools in Cross-Border Resettlement' (DUTT). Within the context of the EU Framework Decisions (FDs) 909 and 947, the aim of the DUTT project has been to study and evaluate the use of Video-Conferencing Technology (VCT) and Touch Screen Facilities (TSF) as a means of enhancing the cross-border resettlement of offenders between EU member states.
