

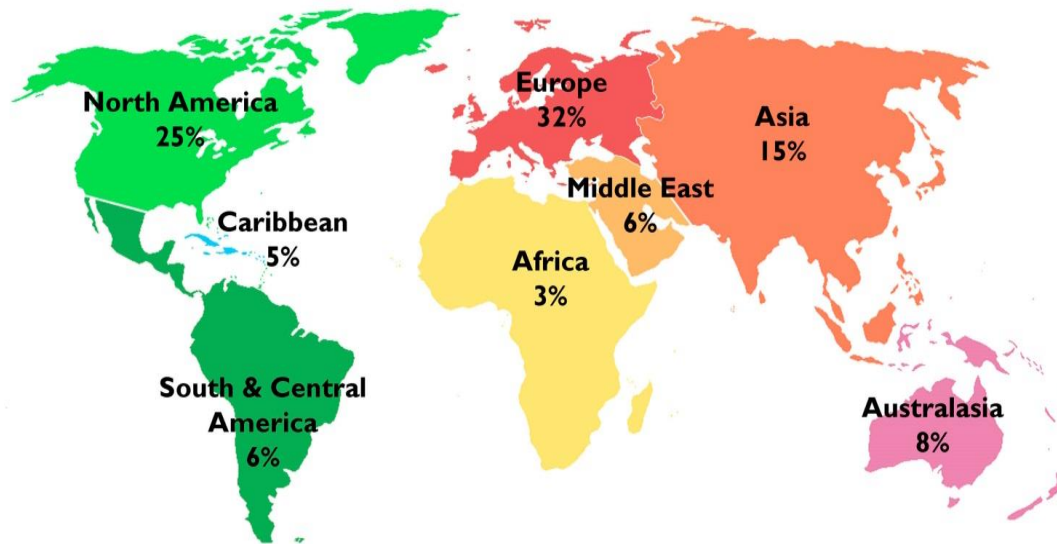

Prisoners Abroad

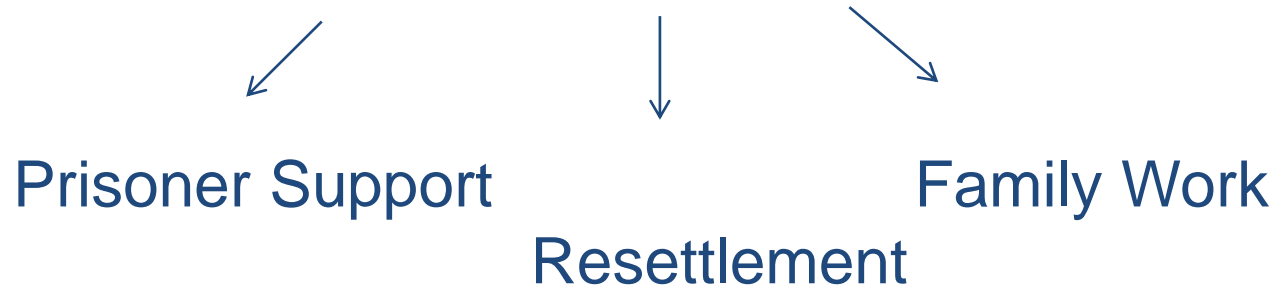
- Formed in 1978.
- In the first year we assisted 30 Britons overseas
- Last year we helped
 - 1,600 prisoners
 - 1,900 family members
 - 183 returning prisoners
- 25 staff based in London
- Annual income: £1.6m

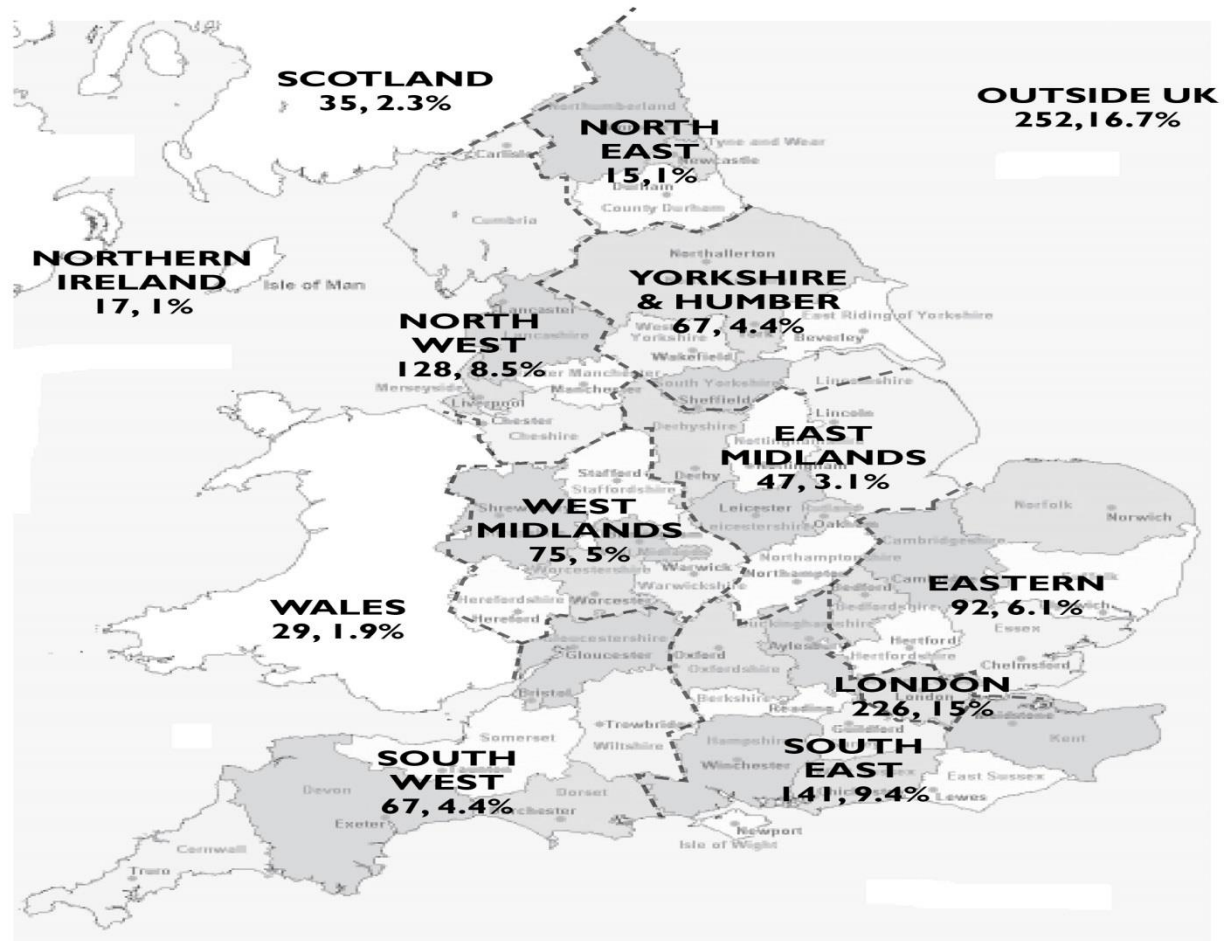
- Craig Feehan Fund survival grants to prisoners in developing countries
