Maintaining change

- They all come back!!!
- Safe return to society – aware of the context/structural influences
- Continuing treatment and monitoring

Mechanisms

- Co-operating with families and peers
 - Discourage interest and involvement in violent extremisms
 - Provide meaningful opportunities and encourage disengagement
 - Provide alternatives
- Involving non-state practitioners in the rehabilitation process
 - Avoid identification of correctional staff as ‘out-group’
 - More credible – same-status
- Mentors – recruitment, selection, training, support, compensation.
- Religious representatives – better understanding of religion, chaplains as confidants, from outside, great prestige, agreements over sensitive information,
- Former violent extremists – provide alternative narratives, experience of leaving, strong credibility, careful support and monitoring
- Victims – direct mediation, through videos or written stories, restorative justice.
- Inter-agency co-operation
