

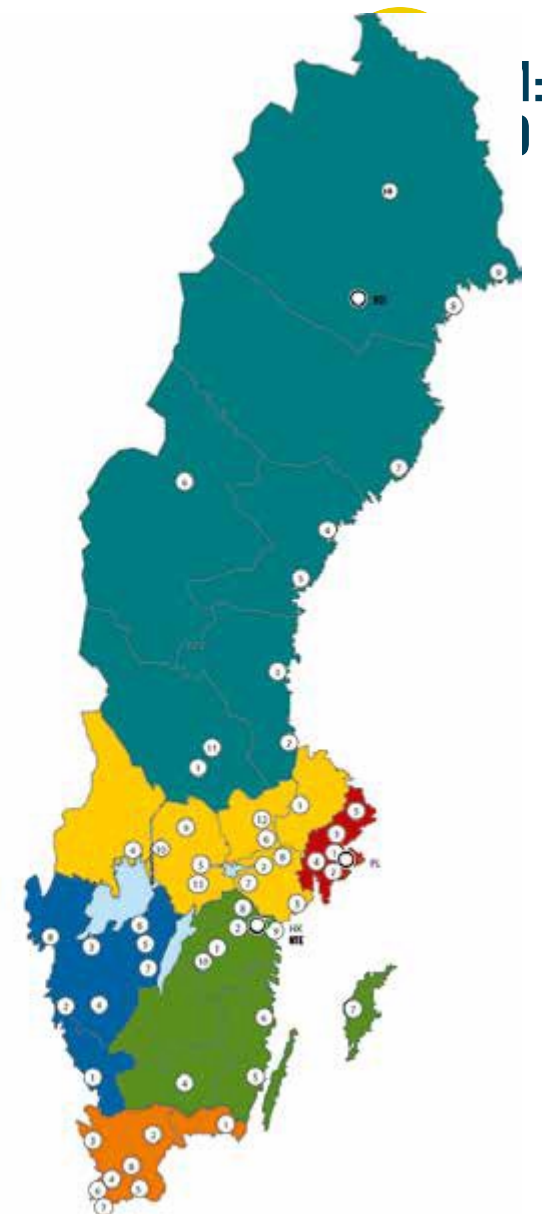
Sex offender treatment in the Swedish Prison and Probation Service

The Swedish Prison & Probation Service

- 46 prisons: 3,800 clients per day
- 33 remand prisons: clients 1,600 per day
- 34 probation offices: 10,700 clients per day

Probation 2015

- 5,854 clients started probation
- 3,396 clients started community service
- 1,835 clients started conditional sentence with electronic monitoring
- 3,976 clients started parole

- Target needs

- Sexual interests (individual sessions)
- Attitudes supporting sexual offending
- Intimacy deficits
- Self-regulation
- Identification of high risk situations

Length of programme

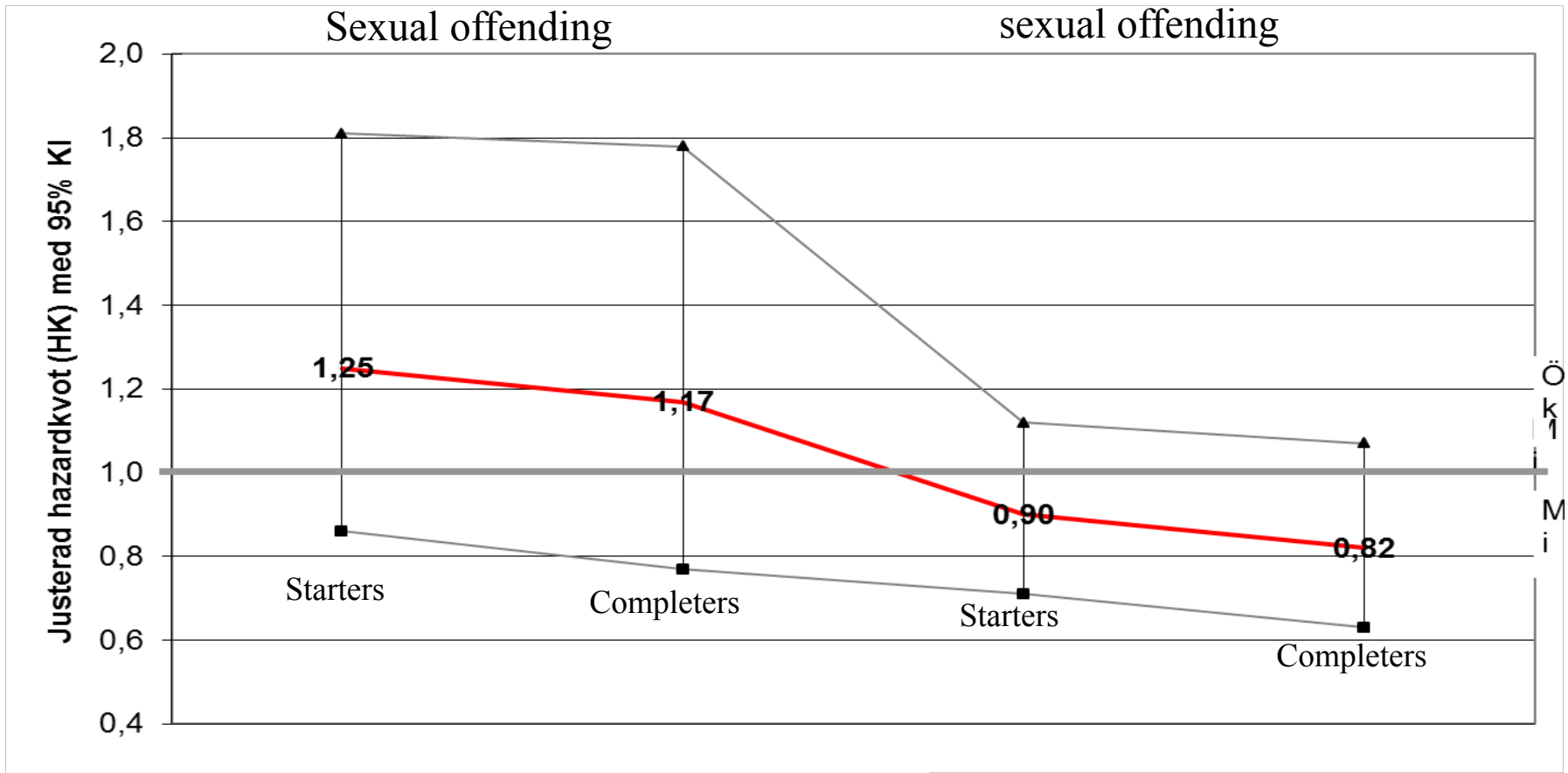

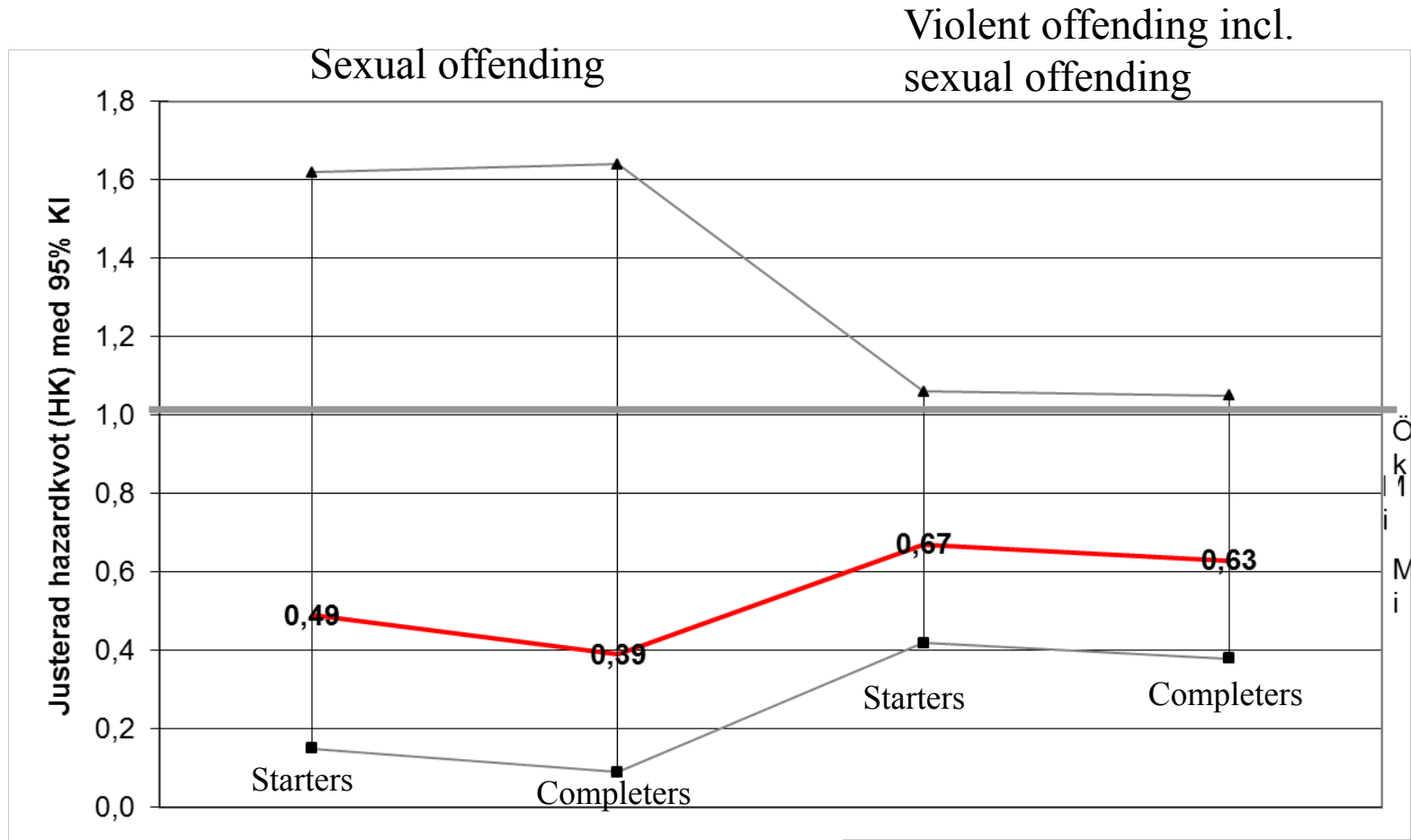
- COSA; one pilot-group in Western Sweden
