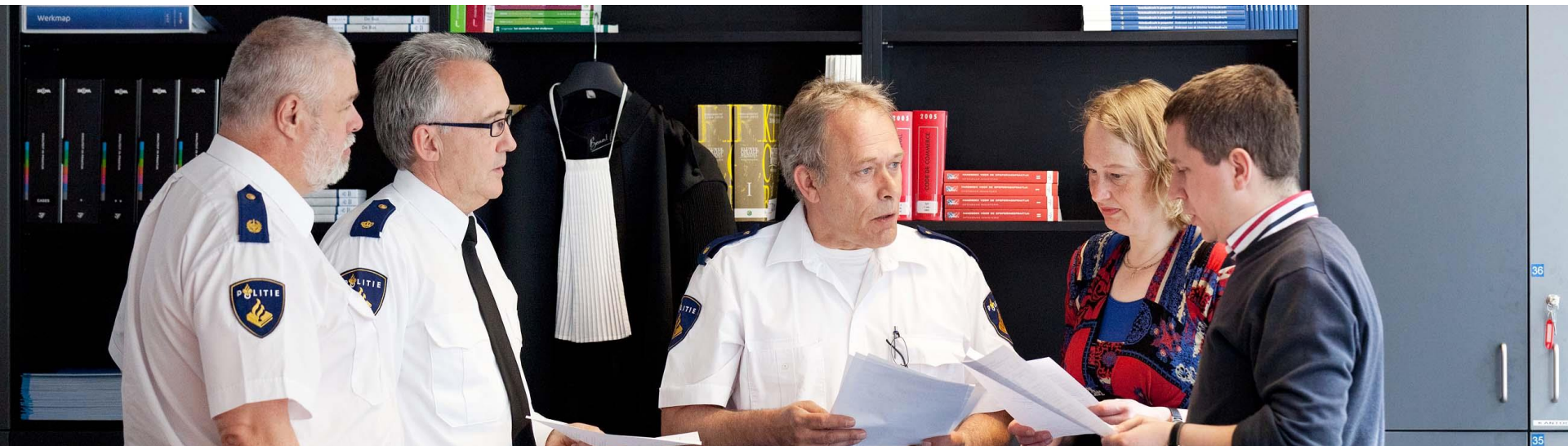

# ZSM (A.S.A.P.) in a nutshell

- Accelerated settlement of sanctions at simple crime, for arrested and summoned accused persons
- Joint initiative Public Prosecution and police. Joint with the three probation organisations, victims support and child protection service.



# ZSM: not run after, but at the same time



- ✓ Public prosecutor is acting earlier in the process
- ✓ Picking up cases at the same time
- ✓ Decline of administrative work / reduce bureaucracy

# Goals

## Focus

To develop a methodology between all the organisations who are participating in the 'justice chain' so they can work together. So cases off criminal law can be settled in an effective and uniform way.

- Raising productivity
- More meaningful punishment for perpetrator, victim and society
- Customer satisfaction
- More trust in the government : "Justice must be done, and it must be seen to be believed."
- Involved staff
- Better cooperation and reduction of costs

# Core values ZSM

- Fast (snel): direct settlement, if .....
- Clever (slim): good organisation of human resource and ICT
- Selective (selectief): more ways for settlement, also not within criminal law, creativity and customized.
- Simple (simpel): minimal and simple registration, less bureaucracy
- Together (samen): all partners together
- Focus on society: a relation between crime and settlement must be recognizable, noticeable and visible.

# Meaning ZSM for....

## Society

- To do justice, prevention
- Being transparent

## Victim

- Clarity, fast compensation and provision of information
- Victim gets a better position in jurisprudence

## Offender

- Clear sanction, direct execution /implementing
- Reduction in recidivism, more knowledge of what happened to victim(s)
