



Guidelines for Private Organisations attending the EM conference

- The Electronic Monitoring conference is intended for practitioners of probation and Electronic Monitoring and therefore commercial representatives of private organisations may only be admitted if there are sufficient conference places available;
- If sufficient places are available, a maximum of two representatives of a private organisation may attend the conference;
- It is not permitted to approach delegates by post and/or by email prior to the conference with letters, promotional materials, etc;
- During the conference it is not permitted for private organisations to organise meetings with delegates in separate meeting rooms;
- It is not permitted to show any equipment to delegates during the conference; Only organisations sponsoring the conference are permitted to show their equipment to delegates;
- If these guidelines are not followed by any representative of a private organisation, then the registration of each representative of this private organisation will be cancelled and/or each representative of this private organisation will be excluded from the conference.

Submitting the registration form for the Electronic Monitoring conference means that these guidelines have been seen and accepted by delegates from private organisations.
