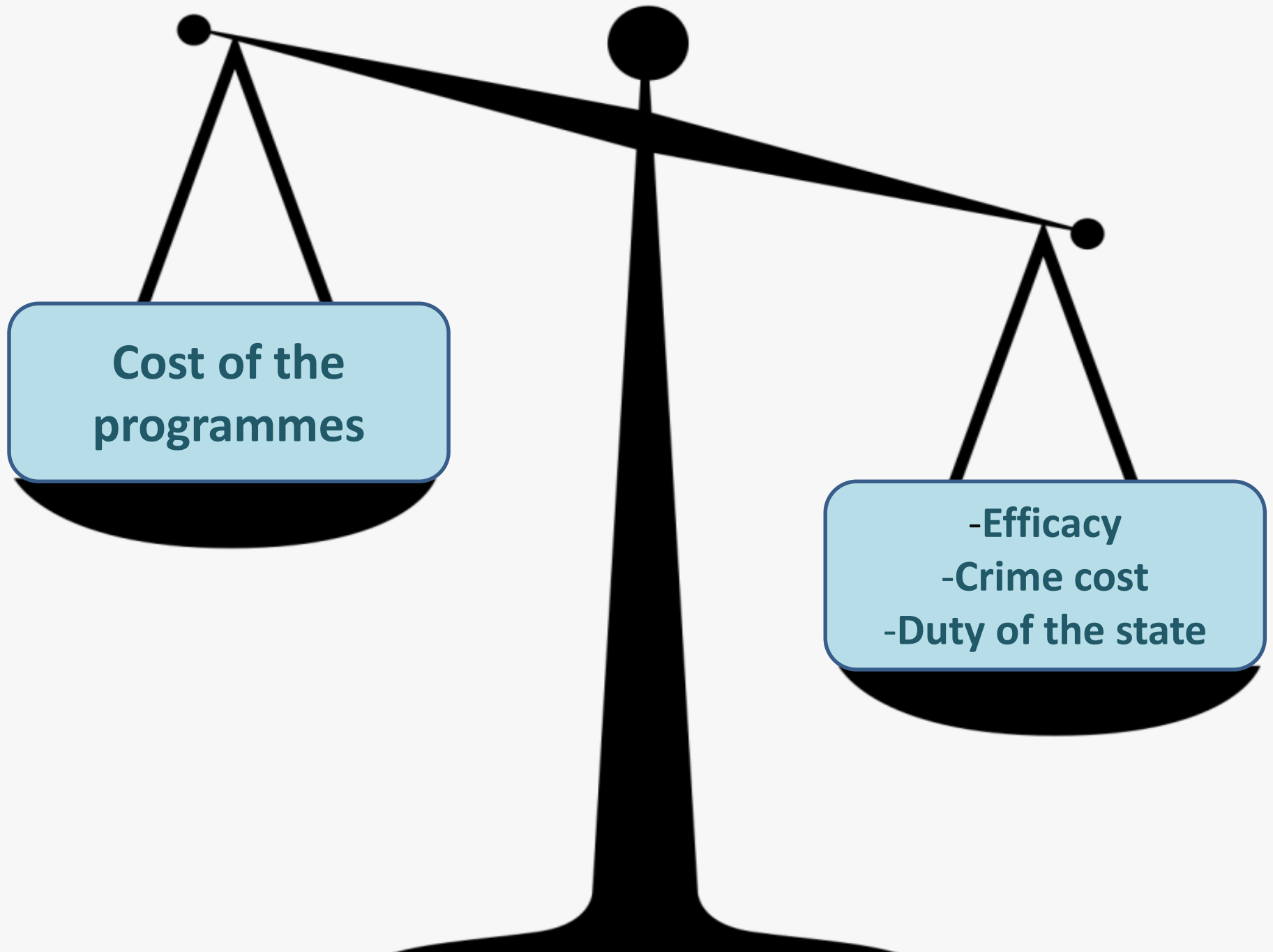

What is the source of financing of programs for perpetrators of DV?

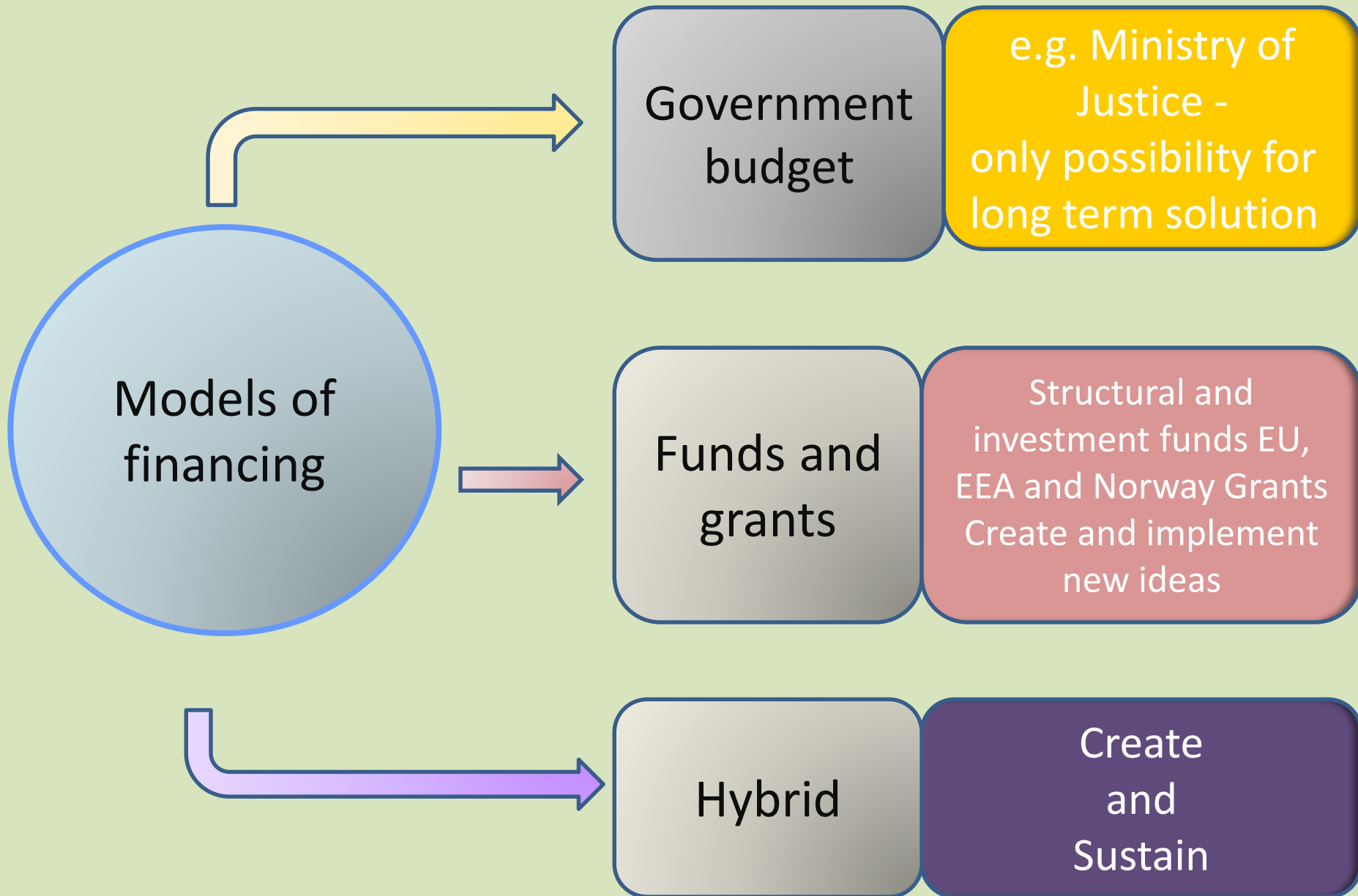
What is the average cost of programme for perpetrators of DV per person in your country?

# Istanbul convention

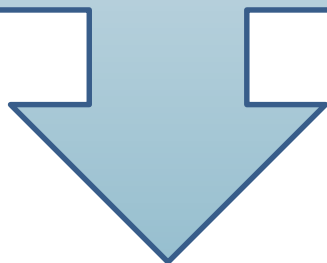
- **Article 8 – Financial resources**

„Parties shall allocate appropriate **financial and human resources** for the adequate implementation of integrated policies, measures and programmes to prevent and combat all forms of violence...

- Problem that occurs when referring to the convention is that it has not been ratified in Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Slovakia and the UK).
