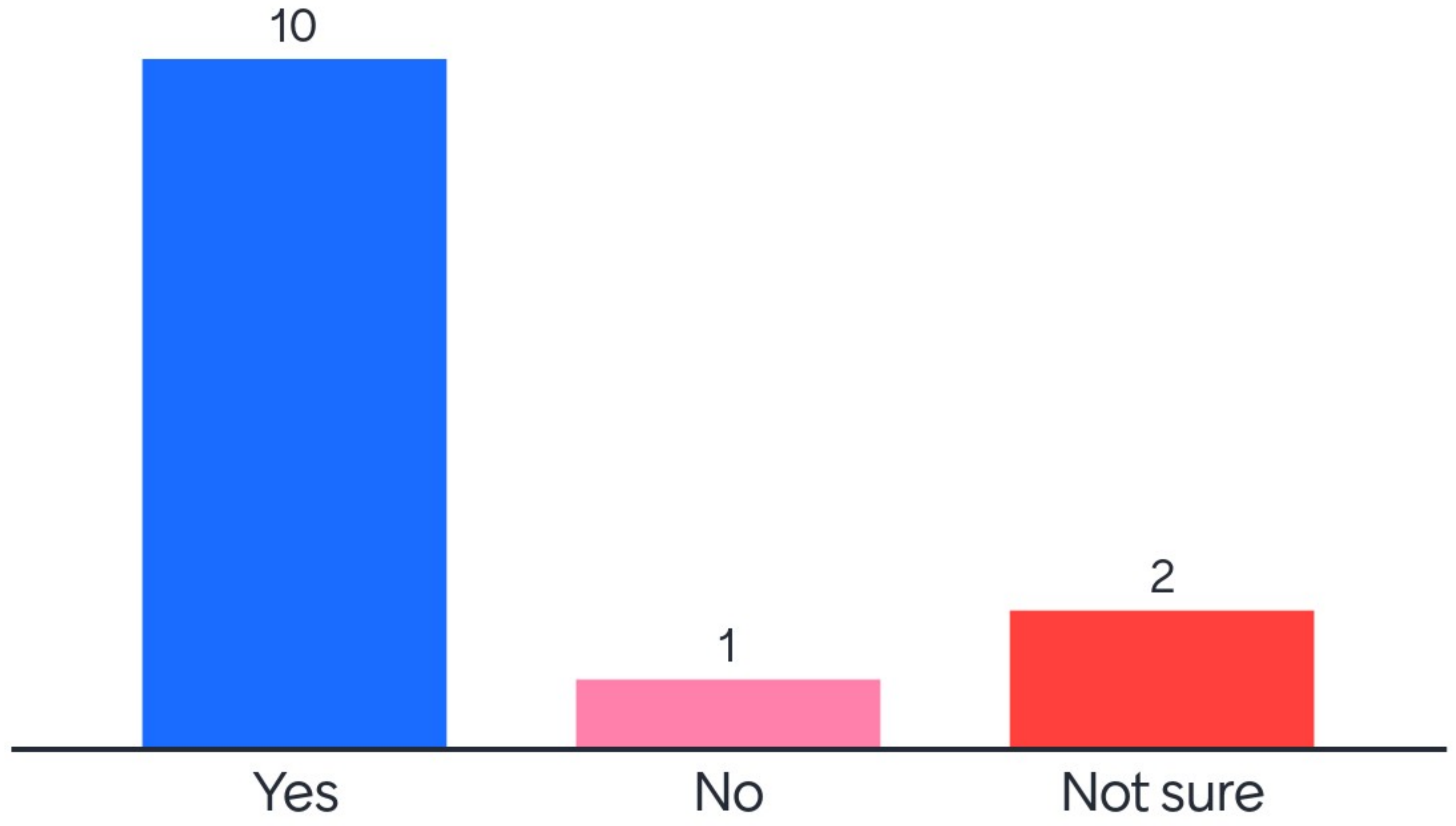


Do the entry level qualifications for probation staff meet CoE Guidelines (i.e. Level 6)



What areas are covered in your induction training for new recruits?

Professional competences.

Masters level- 90 ECTS

Assessment, working alliance, criminal justice procedures, networking

judicial training, working alliance, organizational procedures

Legislation Procedures Reporting drafting Supervision Evidence based methods of rehabilitation etc.

interviewing techniques, reports writing, working alliance, legislation, core correctional practices

Criminal justice context,

There is no official induction training for new probation officers. High degree qualifications and work experience is required to be hired though

working with reluctant clients and resistance

What areas are covered in your induction training for new recruits?

Report writing, risk tools, RNR principles, legislative responsibility, programme interventions,

Risk assessment tool, sentence planning, MI, interagency work, programmes, use of breathelizer

Familiarisation with system ad processes

Mission and attributions of the probation service, public administtrion principles, criminological models, manuals and procedures, professional skills

core cj competencies

Assessment including risk needs assessment

What areas are covered in your ongoing training for probation staff?

New innovations and areas for improvement

Special programmes, data protection

Rehabilitation programmes, teamwork

Specialised topics coming from recent development

Ad hoc- whatever is needed at that time e.g. legislative changes

Risk assessment, work alliance, criminal attitudes, new manuals and procedures, addictions

victim work

Similar to induction so refresher training but also a greater breadth of areas. New developments, inter agency work, improved court room skills, new tools

specific topic but as well more and more staff start the master after some years of experience

What areas are covered in your ongoing training for probation staff?

Similarly there is no official ongoing training in Greece. Probation officers may seek on going training on their own
