Mike Nellis is Emeritus Professor of Criminal and Community Justice in the Law School, University of Strathclyde, Glasgow. He has a PhD on social work with young offenders from the Institute of Criminology, Cambridge, and for many years was involved in training probation officers at the University of Birmingham.

He has written widely on probation services and electronic monitoring (EM), including *Electronically Monitored Punishment: international and critical perspectives*, (2013) co-edited with Kristel Beyens and Dan Kaminski. He has served on two government working parties on EM in Britain, was long associated with the CEP's (European) EM conferences and has co-advised the Council of Europe on the ethics of EM.

He participated in the Pew Centre's EM Advisory Group in Washington, USA in 2018, and is on the editorial board of the *Journal of Offender Monitoring*.
