



## **Workshop session 2**

### **Exploration of the future of AI regarding probation practice and its impact on Electronic Monitoring**

The massive development of an “AI ecosystem” is uncontestable and it is now well spread in the public debate that the AI is a cross cutting subject. If, AI might lead to an impairment of human rights, prisons and probation services seem to embrace a riptide thought as a potential direct application of AI in criminal justice which could effectively defend human rights better than natural human capacity.

This workshop will explore the different variations in which AI can impact criminal justice and probation services. It will present brief examples of how AI has the potential to bring significant benefits. The AI likely will pose new challenges and opportunities for prisons and probations services such as a multiple form of use of EM based on AI thus, this workshop will be a reflexion about ethical risks needed to be taken into consideration to ensure the positive use of AI on criminal justice system.
