Support failure rather than being punitive.

Own will not tested if used without support. Intrusive. Does the breathalyzer support own will better? Only interaction when behavior negative. What's driving the alcohol use - are we addressing these underlying issues? Voluntary or mandated?

Proportionality, who should be monitored and why should it be applied. Is it suitable for everyone. punitive.

What should be the goals of remote alcohol monitoring?

Support to decrease alcohol use
Reduce risk of reoffending (also accidents)
Personal intervention
Support treatment
Self control / coping

To provide supervision at the end of the sentence

To verify alcohol use and use data to discuss and challenge

Reduce risk of alcohol related crime

Control on abuse
Reduction on consumption
User experience
Education to avoid drinking
Lesser criminal activities for a longer period

Behavioural changes, rehabilitation, lower reoffending rate, lower alcohol committed crimes, control, stigma

Psychological support
Behaviour training
Also control/treat the other addictions
Social activities

Personal reports or feedback about their program
Education about the alcohol effects

Helping wider relationships including family, communities

Intervention programs

Long term positive influence

Government savings through reduced offending

Rehabilitation. Counseling.
Probation support. Housing, employment and family support.
Group meetings eg AA
Activities and sport
Weaning center

What additional support should be provided to those subject to remote alcohol monitoring?
