# 9th round of the mutual evaluation

Focused on FD 584 (EAW), FD 909 (Custodial sentences), FD 947 (Probation measures and alternative sanctions), FD 829 (Supervision measures)

Main issues:

- Interconnection between FD 584 and FD 909
- Scarce use of FD 947 and FD 829

Final report ready in March 2023 with the recommendation to the Member States and organizations

# J-CAP project

EU-funded project on the FD 947 (probation measures and alternative sanctions)

Finalized in 2011

Software on the alternative sanctions and probation measures

Similar to the Fiches Belges:

- Short information about the national legislation – which alternative sanctions are possible and under which conditions
- Possibility to compare between the Member States

Project on integration of the software to the EJN website is ongoing

Will be a need to update the information
