## **6 Definitions**

A **high-risk case** in the context of domestic violence exists when there is a concrete risk of homicide or serious violence being committed.

**High-risk management** refers to a systematic and binding procedure in high-risk cases of violence in (ex-)partners, involving joint risk assessment, joint action planning, and joint monitoring to prevent serious, targeted violence.

Risk assessment: Consideration of whether a risk may exist.

- → Risk **analysis**: Information gathering using a standardized tool.
  - → Risk **management**: Development of strategies and protective measures.
