- +90% men






Measures Against Gender Violence

- Transfer of powers to the Autonomous Regions (Royal Decree 474/2021, 29 of june)








Classification by type of crime 2024 (6858)

ALDATUZ

- Founded in 2020
- Community works (art. 49 Spanish Criminal Code)
- Voluntary
- Psycho-educational program
 - 6 sessions, 4 hours each session
 - Group of 12 users
- Exclusion and selection criteria
 - No active drug abuse
 - Without mayor mental disorder
 - Insight capacity

ALDATUZ

MAIN OBJECTIVE

Raise awareness and sensitize to prevent situations of gender-based violence in intimate partner, ex-partner or sporadic relationships, as well as in family relationships (in case of having children).

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Responsability and empathy
- Causes and consequences of their behavior
- Belief system about masculinity
- Strategies for non-violent conflict resolution
- Space for reflection that helps selfknowledge and constructive selfcriticism

ALDATUZ

- 1st session: presentation and group cohesion
- 2nd session: emotions
- 3rd session: jealousy and romantic love
- 4th session: gender stereotypes and symbolic v.
- 5th session: partner violence
- 6th session: new masculinities

GAKOA

- Founded in 2005 and since 2014 part of BCPMS
- Suspended sentences (art. 83 Spanish Criminal Code)
- Conditions to avoid inprisonment (mandatory)
 - Restraining order
 - Prohibition to commit new crimes
- Psycho-terapeutical program (integrative model)
 - Constructivism
 - Logotherapy
 - Cognitive-behavioral components
 - Mindfulness
 - Systemic view

GAKOA

PHASE	OBJECTIVES AND CHARACTERISTICS
First phase	 2-5 individual sessions No confrontation Collect information Therapeutic relationship
Intervention phase	 Individual sessions Individual and group sessions Focus on different aspects of masculinity, emotions and toxic-behaviors.
Monitoring	Evaluation and following-up what was acquired in therapy.

GAKOA

External evaluation carried out by the Basque Institute of Criminology UPV/EHU

- The program has proven to be effective and has managed to reduce the recidivism rate to 8%, while that of the group of aggressors who do not follow the program remains at 20%.
- Only new complaints were taken into account.

SUSTATZEN

- Specific to sexual violence
- Suspended sentences and security measures.
- Psycho-terapeutical program (sex therapy)
- 88 plans in 2022
- 86% plans completed

WORKING WITH GBV OFFENDERS

- Problems arising from the juridical process
- Aggressive behaviors
- Defence mechanisms
 - Minimization
 - Denial
 - Excuses
 - Displace responsability
- Social stigma
- Resistance to change
