

Project "Common Database"

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1. General Principles



May, 2018

- Ministry of Justice and Judical Assistance Baden-Württemberg (BGBW) conculed this agreement
- Description of the necessary processes of transition
- The common goal is to prevent recidivism among offenders

Initial situation: Important information can get lost, although both sides have a large database is present

August 2019, BGBW and the Ministry of Justice set up a working group of practitioners

→ Analyze the possibility and the effects of a common database between the prison service and the BGBW

In February 2020: The working group developed a set of criteria covering all relevant areas of information for the process of a successful transition management.

In April 2022: This catalog was presented at the conference on transition management to all stakeholders involved.

Pilot project "Common database" was designed. This project was carried out in the period from 01.04.2023 - 31.12.2023.

In total, all BGBW probation officers and 47 social workers from prisons participated

3. Evaluation



Information is very useful for social workers in prison (90,35%)



Information is very useful for correctional planning in prison (73,70%)



Information is very useful for assessment (68,40%)



By using the same documentation system, prison and phation staff had more contact (61,65%)

Results of evaluation sheets

- We used the tool "unfrageonline.de"
- 98 responses (return rate of 32,8%)
- 299 project cases

Benefits (Results of the monthly meetings)



Prisoners/Clients

- Improved Transition
- Improving security situation (e.g. suicidality)
- Important informations about the social situation before/after imprisonment
- Prisoner does not have to provide information about his/her biography in several places



• All prison

Social Workers

- All documents relating to a prisoner are already available
- An overwiew of the probation process is available
- Better and earlier correactional planning is possible
- Improvement of security of prison staff by providing important information



Probation Officers

- All documents relating to a client are already available
- The assessment can be started earlier
- Improvement of security of probation staff by providing important information
